- 6 have sixty (60) days from the effective date of this amendatory
- 7 act to comply with the requirements of this section.

- 9 Section 1626. Reporting by Candidate and Political
- 10 Committees and other Persons.
- 11 (a) Each treasurer of a political committee [and each
- 12 candidate for election to public office] shall file with the
- 13 appropriate supervisor reports of receipts and expenditures on
- 14 forms, designed by the Secretary of the Commonwealth, if the
- 15 amount received [or expended or liabilities incurred] and the
- 16 <u>amount of expenditures</u> shall exceed the sum of two hundred fifty
- 17 dollars (\$250). [Should such an amount not exceed two hundred
- 18 fifty dollars (\$250), then the candidate or the treasurer of the
- 19 committee shall file a sworn statement to that effect with the
- 20 appropriate supervisor rather than the report required by this
- 21 section.
- 22 (a.1) Each candidate for election to public office shall
- 23 file with the appropriate supervisor reports of receipts and
- 24 <u>expenditures on forms, designed by the Secretary of the</u>
- 25 <u>Commonwealth</u>, if the amount received or expended or liabilities
- 26 <u>incurred shall exceed the sum of two hundred fifty dollars</u>
- 27 (\$250). Should such an amount not exceed two hundred fifty
- 28 dollars (\$250), then the candidate shall file a sworn statement
- 29 to that effect with the appropriate supervisor rather than the
- 30 report required by this section.

- 8 which shall be complete as of January 15 of each year. Such

- 10 balance or debt in the report of the candidate or political
- 11 committee. Such reports shall be cumulative. However, if there
- 12 has been no change in the account, then the candidate or
- 13 political committee shall file a statement to that effect with

- 20 (B) ANY POLITICAL COMMITTEE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER

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- 21 THIS ACT AND NOT REPORTING UNDER SECTION 1626 SHALL FILE AN
- 22 ANNUAL REPORT UNDER THIS SECTION. HOWEVER, IF A POLITICAL
- 23 COMMITTEE MAKES AGGREGATE EXPENDITURES AS DEFINED IN SECTION
- 24 1621 IN AN AMOUNT LESS THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) OR INCURS
- 25 AGGREGATE DEBT IN AN AMOUNT LESS THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100)
- 26 DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR TO INFLUENCE AN ELECTION, IT NEED NOT
- 27 FILE AN ANNUAL REPORT; PROVIDED THAT THIS EXCEPTION SHALL NOT BE
- 28 APPLICABLE TO A CANDIDATE'S POLITICAL COMMITTEE OR TO A STATE OR
- 29 COUNTY COMMITTEE OF A POLITICAL PARTY OR POLITICAL BODY.
