AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 20, 1979 (No.51), entitled "An act
 - establishing a uniform mileage fee for all officials,
- 3 officers and employees of the Commonwealth, its political
- 4 subdivisions, intermediate units, and authorities,"
- 5 permitting mileage to be fixed by collective bargaining
- 6 agreements.

- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 1, act of July 20, 1979 (No.51), entitled
- 10 "An act establishing a uniform mileage fee for all officials,
- 11 officers and employees of the Commonwealth, its political
- 12 subdivisions, intermediate units, and authorities," is amended
- 13 to read:
- 14 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other act
- 15 to the contrary the mileage fee to be charged and received by
- 16 any official, officer or employee of the Commonwealth, its
- 17 departments, bureaus, boards, commissions, agencies and
- 18 authorities and any official, officer or employee of its
- 19 political subdivisions or authorities created thereby, or of an

- 1 intermediate unit shall be 17¢ per mile, unless [a lesser rate
- 2 is adopted by the department, bureau, board, commission, agency,
- 3 authority, political subdivision or intermediate unit] a
- 4 collective bargaining agreement between a public employer and a
- 5 union certified as an exclusive representative OR ARBITRATION
- 6 AWARD pursuant to provisions of the act of July 23, 1970
- 7 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the "Public Employe Relations Act,"
- 8 or the act of June 24, 1968 (P.L.237, No.111), referred to as
- 9 the Policemen and Firemen Collective Bargaining Act, provides a
- 10 <u>different rate</u>, in which case the rate specified in the
- 11 <u>collective bargaining agreement shall be the effective rate for</u>
- 12 employees covered by that collective bargaining agreement and
- 13 that rate may be extended to other employees of that public
- 14 employer at the employer's discretion. In the absence of a
- 15 <u>collective bargaining agreement provision establishing a mileage</u>

- 16 fee, a rate of less OTHER than 17c may be adopted by the
- 17 <u>department</u>, <u>bureau</u>, <u>commission</u>, <u>agency</u>, <u>authority</u>, <u>political</u>
- 18 subdivision or intermediate unit.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall
- 20 be retroactive to July 20, 1979.
