AN ACT

Amending the act of July 4, 1979 (P.L.665, No.10A), entitled "An act appropriating the Federal Augmentation to the Executive 2 3 and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth and establishing restricted receipts accounts for the fiscal period July 1, 4 1979 to June 30, 1980 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending 6 7 June 30, 1979, "changing appropriations and adding 8 appropriations. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1.
