## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and 3 brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and 4 changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, 6 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding 7 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic 8 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, 11 12 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective 13 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure 14 15 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; 16 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," 17 defining the term "resort area." 18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 19 20 Section 1. Section 102, act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, 21 No.21), known as the "Liquor Code," is amended by adding a 22 definition to read:
- 23 Section 102. Definitions.--The following words or phrases,
- 24 unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, shall have the
- 25 meanings ascribed to them in this section:

- 2 "Resort area" shall mean any municipality which, in the
- 3 <u>determination of the board, has a heavy seasonal influx of</u>
- 4 persons participating in recreational activities and in which
- 5 <u>substantial transient living and eating accommodations exist.</u>
- For the purposes of this definition recreational activities 6
- 7 shall include but are not limited to, skiing, golfing, hunting
- and fishing.

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
