12	INVOLUNTARY DEVIATE SEXUAL INTERCOURSE.	
13	(A) CIVIL ACTION PROHIBITED No person convicted of the	<
14	crime of rape OR INVOLUNTARY DEVIATE SEXUAL INTERCOURSE shall	<
15	bring or maintain any action against his victim for any act or	
16	omission relating to the offense for which he was convicted.	
17	(B) LEGAL EXPENSES THE COST OF ALL REASONABLE LEGAL	<
18	EXPENSES INCURRED BY A VICTIM IN DEFENDING AGAINST A CIVIL	

- 1 ACTION AS DESCRIBED ABOVE SHALL BE BORNE BY THE COMMONWEALTH, IF
- 2 THE DEFENDENT IS FINANCIALLY UNABLE TO BEAR THE LEGAL COSTS
- 3 RELATING TO THE ACTION.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
