- 9 That subsection (b) of section 2 of Article VIII be amended
- 10 by adding a clause to read:
- 11 § 2. Exemptions and special provisions.

- 15 (v) Establish standards and qualifications by which local
- 16 taxing authorities may make uniform special real property tax
- 17 provisions applicable to taxpayers who are longtime owner-
- 18 occupants as shall be defined by the General Assembly of

- 1 <u>residences in areas where real property values have risen</u>
- 2 <u>markedly as a consequence of the refurbishing or renovating of</u>
- 3 other deteriorating residences or the construction of new
- 4 <u>residences</u>.
