RESOLVED, That House Rule 17 be amended to read:

RULE 17

Order of Business

The daily order of business shall be:

1. Prayer by the Chaplain.

1(a). Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Correction and approval of the Journal.

3. Leaves of Absence.

4. Master Roll Call.

5. Reports of Committee.

6. First consideration bills.

7. Second consideration bills.

8. Final passage bills recalled from the Governor.

9. Final passage bills (bills on final passage postponed  
calendar may be called up under this order of business).

10. Third consideration bills (bills on third consideration  
postponed calendar may be called up under this order of  
business).

- 1        11. Resolutions (House and concurrent).
- 2        12. Messages from the Senate and communications from the
- 3            Governor.
- 4        13. Reference to appropriate committees of bills,
- 5            resolutions, petitions, memorials, remonstrances and
- 6            other papers.
- 7        14. Unfinished business on the Speaker's table.
- 8        15. Announcements.
- 9        16. Adjournment.

10       Any question may, by a majority vote of the House, be made a  
11 special order of business. When the time arrives for its  
12 consideration, the Speaker shall lay the special order of  
13 business before the House.
