23	General and State Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed	
24	to borrow, from time to time, in addition to any authorization

Estimated Useful Life of Project PROJECTS. -- The <-----3 General Assembly states the estimated useful life of the public 4 improvement project PROJECTS heretofore itemized is not less <----than 30 years from the date of completion thereof, which period 5 6 is hereby stated to be the term of the debt to be incurred. 7 Section 4. Appropriation. -- The net proceeds of the sale of 8 obligations herein authorized are hereby appropriated from the 9 Capital Facilities Fund to the Department of General Services in the maximum amount of $\frac{33,640,000}{56,983,000}$ to be used by it 10 <-----11 exclusively to defray the financial cost of the public 12 improvement project PROJECTS specifically itemized herein. After <-----13 reserving or paying the expenses of the sale of the obligations, the State Treasurer shall pay out to the Department of General 14 15 Services the moneys as required and certified by it to be 16 legally due and payable.

Section 5. Effective Date.--This act shall take effectimmediately.

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
