AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, NO.69), entitled "An  
2 act concerning townships of the second class; and amending,  
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating  
4 thereto," permitting supervisors to be members of a township  
5 planning commission.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 410, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69),  
9 known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended  
10 July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567) and amended July 29, 1977  
11 (P.L.151, No.39), is amended to read:

12 Section 410. Supervisors.--(a) Except as is otherwise  
13 provided for the election of additional supervisors, at each  
14 municipal election, the electors of each township shall elect  
15 one supervisor to serve for a term of six years from the first  
16 Monday of January next following his election.

17 (b) Except as provided in section 514, no supervisor shall  
18 at the same time hold any other elective or appointive township  
19 office or position other than township roadmaster or secretary-

1 treasurer. Nothing in this subsection shall prohibit a  
2 supervisor from being a member of a township planning commission  
3 created pursuant to the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247),  
4 known as the "Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code."

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
