AN ACT

- 1 Imposing limitations on the power of the General Assembly to 2 override vetoes of the Governor.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. (a) The General Assembly shall have a total of
- 6 12 legislative days in which to exercise its constitutional
- 7 power to override any veto of the Governor.
- 8 (b) The time period of 12 legislative days shall be
- 9 determined by the legislative calendar of the house of origin of
- 10 the vetoed legislation. The time period shall begin to run on
- 11 the first legislative day occurring after the vetoed legislation
- 12 and the Governor's veto message is delivered to the legislative
- 13 house of origin.
- 14 Section 2. Within the 12 legislative day period, each House
- 15 of the General Assembly shall be limited to three and only to
- 16 three attempts to override a Governor's veto.
- 17 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
