AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 24, 1963 (P.L.1132, No.484), entitled 2 "An act providing for the creation, establishment and 3 operation of community colleges, granting certain powers to the State Board of Education, the Council of Higher Education 4 and the Department of Public Instruction; authorizing school 5 districts, county boards of school directors and 6 7 municipalities to sponsor community colleges; authorizing 8 school districts and municipalities to levy certain taxes; providing for reimbursements by the Commonwealth of certain 9 costs and expenses, and making an appropriation, " further 10 11 providing for payments by the Commonwealth. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 13 14 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 14, act of August 24, 1963 (P.L.1132, No.484), known as the "Community College Act of 15 1963, " amended December 9, 1980 (P.L.1119, No.196), is amended 16 17 to read: 18 Section 14. Financial Program; Reimbursement or Payments.--19

1 (b) (1) The Commonwealth shall pay to a community college on behalf of the sponsor on account of its operating costs 2 3 during the fiscal year from funds appropriated for that purpose 4 an amount equal to one-third of such college's approved 5 operating costs not to exceed one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) for fiscal years up to and including 1979-1980 [and], 6 one thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,800) for fiscal [year] 7 8 YEARS 1980-1981 AND 1981-1982 and two thousand four hundred <-<u>dollars (\$2,400) for fiscal year 1981 1982 1982-1983</u> and 9 <-----10 thereafter per student multiplied by the number of equivalent 11 full-time students determined by an audit to be made in a manner prescribed by the State Board of Education. In addition the 12 13 Commonwealth shall pay to a community college on account of its 14 operating costs for all equivalent full-time students enrolled 15 in two-year or less than two-year terminal non-liberal arts 16 programs, a sum of [one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150)] for <-----17 fiscal years up to and including 1980 1981 and three hundred 18 dollars (\$300) for fiscal year 1981 1982 and thereafter for each <-----19 such equivalent full-time student. The Secretary of Education shall have the power and his duty shall be to designate the 20 21 programs of study which conform to the intent of this act. Each 22 community college shall maintain such accounting and student 23 attendance records on generally accepted principles and standards as will lend themselves to satisfactory audit. The 24 25 Commonwealth shall pay to a community college on behalf of the 26 sponsor on account of its capital expenses an amount equal to 27 one-half of such college's annual capital expenses from funds 28 appropriated for that purpose to the extent that said capital 29 expenses have been approved as herein provided.

30 (2) For purposes of determining Commonwealth reimbursement 19810H0390B2731 - 2 - of operating costs, Federally funded expenditures for those
 programs in which the Commonwealth participates in the cost
 shall be deducted from total operating expenditures to determine
 net reimbursable operating costs.
