## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 18 19 commissions shall be determined, " prohibiting the Department 20 21 of Transportation from expending any public funds for an 22 emission inspection program.

- 24 hereby enacts as follows:
- 25 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 26 as "The Administrative Code of 1929," is amended by adding a
- 27 section to read:

- Section 2013. Prohibition on Expenditures for Emission 1
- 2 <u>Inspection Program. -- The department shall not expend any public</u>
- 3 <u>funds on any program for the inspection of emissions of motor</u>
- 4 <u>vehicles</u>.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
