1 2 3 4 5	Authorizing and directing the Department of General Services, with the approval of the Department of Public Welfare and the Governor, to convey to the Abington Area Line Officers Association, 27 acres of land, more or less, situate in Newton Township, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania.
6	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. The Department of General Services, with the
9	approval of the Department of Public Welfare and the Governor,
10	is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Commonwealth
11	of Pennsylvania, to grant and convey to the Abington Area Line
12	Officers Association, the following tract of land situate in the
13	Township of Newton, County of Lackawanna and Commonwealth of
14	Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:
15	Beginning at a concrete monument corner on the southerly
16	right-of-way of Legislative Route 35018, said corner being the
17	most northeasterly corner of the Abington Heights School
18	District (Middle School) and common with other lands of the
19	grantor herein; thence along the southerly right-of-way of said

Legislative Route 35018 south 75 degrees 25 minutes 00 seconds 1 east a distance of 99.48 feet to a concrete monument corner; 2 3 thence continuing along the southerly right-of-way line of 4 Legislative Route 35018 and also along the southerly right-ofway line of Legislative Route 440 south 83 degrees 16 minutes 59 5 seconds east a distance of 696.52 feet to a concrete monument 6 7 corner; thence across said Legislative Route 440 and along other lands of the grantor herein north 6 degrees 58 minutes 50 8 seconds east a distance of 1492.64 feet to a corner; thence 9 10 continuing along the lands of the grantor herein south 82 11 degrees 49 minutes 59 seconds east a distance of 800.00 feet to a corner; thence still along the lands of the grantor herein and 12 13 crossing Legislative Route 440 and Legislative Route 35018 south 7 degrees 10 minutes 01 second east a distance of 1500.00 feet 14 15 to the place of beginning. Containing 27.29 acres of land be the 16 same more or less.

Excepting from the above described all that land encompassed by the right-of-ways for Legislative Route 440 and Legislative Route 35018.

20 The conveyance shall be made under and subject to all easements, servitudes and rights of others, including but not 21 22 confined to streets, roadways and rights of telephone, telegraph, water, electric, sewer, gas or pipeline companies, as 23 24 well as under and subject to any interest, estates or tenancies 25 vested in any third persons, whether or not appearing of record 26 for any portion of the land or improvement erected thereon. 27 Section 2. The Deed of Conveyance shall contain a clause that the lands conveyed shall be used as a training school for 28 29 State volunteer firefighters by the Abington Area Line Officers 30 Association and if at any time the said association or its 19810H0769B0827 - 2 -

successor in function conveys said property or authorizes or
permits said property to be used for any purpose other than fire
fighting purposes, the title thereto shall immediately revert to
and revest in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

5 Section 3. The Deed of Conveyance shall be approved by the 6 Office of General Counsel and shall be executed by the Secretary 7 of General Services in the name of the Commonwealth of 8 Pennsylvania. Cost and fees incidental to the conveyance shall 9 be borne by the grantee.

10 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
