AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled  
2 "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth,  
3 sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising,  
4 consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto,"  
5 further providing for the appointment of assistant county  
6 solicitors.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 904, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323,  
10 No.130), known as "The County Code," amended October 18, 1972  
11 (P.L.970, No.236), is amended to read:

12 Section 904. Assistant County Solicitors [in Third, Fourth,  
13 Fifth and Sixth Class Counties.--In counties of the third class,  
14 the].--The county commissioners may appoint not more than three  
15 assistant county solicitors, and, with the approval of the court  
16 of common pleas, special counsel who shall be attorneys at law  
17 admitted to practice in the courts of this Commonwealth. [In  
18 counties of the fourth, fifth and sixth classes, the county  
19 commissioners may appoint an assistant solicitor who shall be an

1 attorney at law admitted to practice in the courts of this  
2 Commonwealth.] Each assistant and special counsel shall perform  
3 such duties in connection with the legal affairs of the county  
4 as may be assigned to him by the county commissioners or the  
5 county solicitor.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
