AN ACT

1 Transferring certain powers, duties, appropriations, personnel,
2 furniture, equipment, files, records, papers, contracts or
3 obligations from the Department of Transportation to the
4 Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. (a) Powers, duties and functions transferred.--

8 All the powers, duties and functions vested in and performed by
9 the Department of Transportation are hereby transferred to the
10 Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission.

11 (b) Personnel, appropriations, equipment, etc.

12 transferred.--All personnel, allocations, appropriations,
13 equipment, files, records, contracts, agreements, obligations
14 and other material which are used, employed or expanded in
15 connection with the powers, duties or functions transferred by
16 this act to the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission are hereby
17 transferred to the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission with the

1 same force and effect as if the appropriations had been made to
2 and said items had been the property of the Pennsylvania
3 Turnpike Commission in the first instance and as if said
4 contracts, agreements and obligations had been incurred or
5 entered into by the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission.

6 (c) Retention of civil service status.--All personnel
7 transferred pursuant to this act shall retain any civil service
8 employment status assigned to said personnel.

9 Section 2. The Department of Transportation is hereby
10 abolished.

11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
