AN ACT

Amending the act of September 18, 1961 (P.L.1389, No.615), 2 entitled "An act establishing and taking over as State 3 highways certain county highways, or sections thereof, tunnels, bridges, viaducts and approaches thereto, in 5 counties, and certain streets and bridges in cities of the first class and in cities of the second class, and certain 7 streets in cities of the second class A and third class, and certain township roads and certain streets in boroughs and 8 9 incorporated towns; authorizing under certain terms and 10 conditions their construction, maintenance, repair, reconstruction and improvement by the Commonwealth; 11 12 conferring certain powers upon Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for 13 14 sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such 15 highways; and deleting certain State highways, " amending a 16 route in Delaware County. 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 18 19 Section 1. As much of section 402 as relates to Route 23131 20 in Delaware County, act of September 18, 1961 (P.L.1389, No.615) 21 referred to as the County and Municipal State Highway Law is 22 amended to read: 23 Section 402. The township roads to be taken over are situate
