AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11 elections," providing for certificates of voting.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known
15 as the "Pennsylvania Election Code," is amended by adding a
16 section to read:

17 Section 1217.1. Certificate of Voting.--(a) After each
18 person has voted and as he leaves the voting booth or voting
19 machine compartment an election official shall give him a
20 certificate signed by the judge of election that he has voted in
21 the particular election designated which certificate shall also
22 contain the voter's name and address and the date of the

1 election.

2 (b) A certificate of voting shall be absolute proof of
3 voting at an election and shall be worth a credit of twenty-five
4 dollars (\$25) against the State income tax payable by the voter.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
