## AN ACT

1 Requiring the superintendent of every public school to make 2 available, upon request, lists of graduating seniors to 3 military recruiters and providing a penalty for the misuse of 4 any such lists.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. It is the intent of the General Assembly through 8 this legislation to fulfill its moral obligations and assist military recruiters to achieve additional access to potential 9 recruits by compiling a list of prospective graduating seniors 10 11 for distribution, on request, to military recruiters. 12 Section 2. (a) Subject to the limitations of subsection 13 (b), the superintendent of every public school district AND THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATOR OF EVERY PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOL shall 14 15 compile a list of senior students, both male and female, INCLUDING HOME ADDRESS AND PUBLISHED TELEPHONE NUMBER who at the 16

end of the respective academic year will graduate from the
 public school system. The list shall be compiled WITHIN 45
 CALENDAR DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT AND IN
 SUCCEEDING YEARS by the first day of the academic year in which
 the senior students will graduate.

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(b) Prior to the end of any student's junior year, the 6 student may request the superintendent OR CHIEF ADMINISTRATOR, 7 <----in writing, to exclude such student's name from the list 8 9 required pursuant to subsection (a). Each school district AND <\_\_\_\_ 10 PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOL shall notify the students, in writing, at the end of their junior year of the requirements imposed by 11 subsection (a). EACH STUDENT SHALL BE GIVEN AT LEAST 21 CALENDAR 12 <---13 DAYS TO REQUEST EXCLUSION OF SUCH STUDENTS NAMES PRIOR TO THE RELEASE OF SUCH LIST. 14

Section 3. (a) Any list prepared pursuant to subsection (a) <-</p>
shall be made available only to military recruiters for the
active component, the reserve component or the National Guard
component of the armed forces who request, in writing, a copy of
the list.

20 (b) Any list obtained pursuant to subsection (a) shall be
21 used solely for the purpose of soliciting potential recruits for
22 the active component, the reserve component or the National
23 Guard component of the armed forces.

Section 4. Any person who violates any section of this act commits a misdemeanor of the third degree and upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$2,500.

27 SECTION 3. (A) ALL LISTS PREPARED PURSUANT TO THIS ACT MAY
28 BE MADE AVAILABLE, WITH OR WITHOUT FEE, TO SUCH PERSONS AS ARE
29 DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY VOTE OF THE BOARD OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS OR
30 THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF ANY PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOL WHEN
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1 REQUESTED IN WRITING.

2 (B) SUCH LISTS MUST BE MADE AVAILABLE TO MILITARY RECRUITERS 3 FOR THE ACTIVE COMPONENT, THE RESERVE COMPONENT OR THE NATIONAL 4 GUARD COMPONENT OF THE ARMED FORCES WHEN REQUESTED IN WRITING. 5 Section <del>5</del> 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
