- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, changing the period allowed for temporary permits.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 2102(d) of Title 75, act of November 25,
- 6 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes, added June 18, 1980 (P.L.229, No.68), is amended to
- 8 read:
- 9 § 2102. Identification markers required.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (d) Operation without identification marker unlawful.--It
- 12 shall be unlawful to operate or to cause to be operated in this
- 13 Commonwealth any motor carrier vehicle unless the vehicle bears
- 14 the identification marker required by this section.
- 15 (1) The Secretary of Revenue may by regulation exempt
- from the requirement to display the identification marker
- 17 motor carrier vehicles which in his opinion are clearly

- identifiable such that effective enforcement of this chapter will not suffer thereby.
- 3 (2) For a period not exceeding [five] twenty-five days
 4 as to any one motor carrier, the Secretary of Revenue by
 5 letter or telegram may authorize the operation of a motor
 6 carrier vehicle or vehicles without the identification marker
 7 required when the enforcement of this section for that period
 8 would cause undue delay and hardship in the operation of such
 9 motor carrier vehicle or vehicles:
- 10 (i) The fee for such permits shall be \$5 for each
 11 motor carrier vehicle.
- 12 (ii) Conditions for the issuance of such permits 13 shall be set forth in regulations promulgated by the 14 Department of Revenue.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
