AN ACT

- 1 Requiring the Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police to
 - hire persons without regard to race, religion, sex or imposed

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of any law
- 7 decree or order to the contrary, the Commissioner of the State
- 8 Police shall hire or employ persons without regard to race,
- 9 religion, sex or any type of "quota system."
- 10 (b) All persons hired by the State Police after the
- 11 effective date of this act shall be selected solely on the basis
- 12 of merit and qualifications.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
