AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for bidding for certain supplies and materials and making an editorial correction.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Clause (6) of section 2004.1, act of March 10,
- 11 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949,"
- 12 added February 17, 1970 (P.L.24, No.13), is amended to read:
- 13 Section 2004.1. Management of State Colleges and State
- 14 Universities within the Department. -- Subject to the stated
- 15 authority of the Board of State College and University Directors
- 16 and the boards of trustees, the president of each of the several
- 17 State Colleges and State Universities shall administer the
- 18 institution. Each president shall have the power and his duty

- 1 shall be:
- 2 * * *
- 3 (6) To purchase instructional materials, educational,
- 4 technical, administrative, custodial and maintenance equipment
- 5 and supplies not in excess of a cost of [one thousand five
- 6 hundred dollars (\$1,500)] five thousand dollars (\$5,000) without
- 7 competitive bidding with the approval of the Board of Trustees,
- 8 after notice to the Secretary of [Property and Supplies] General
- 9 <u>Services</u>, except that such items shall not be bought in series
- 10 to avoid the dollar ceiling, nor shall any items be included for
- 11 which the Department of [Property and Supplies] General Services
- 12 has contracts, either through schedules or group purchase
- 13 contracts, current or proposed. The Department of Education
- 14 shall annually calculate the percentage change in the Consumer
- 15 Price Index for the preceding year as published by the United
- 16 States Bureau of Labor Statistics. The bidding ceiling shall be
- 17 increased by this percentage change on July 1 of each year. The
- 18 resulting figure shall be applicable to purchases made by each
- 19 of the State Colleges and State Universities during the ensuing
- 20 <u>fiscal year.</u>

- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
