AN ACT

1 Repealing the act of June 13, 1907 (P.L.539, No.347), entitled
2 "An act giving the Board of Public Charities,--in the
3 consideration of applications for approval of plans and
4 specifications for the erection of buildings, referred to
5 them by law, and the consideration of applications for
6 recommendations to the Legislature of appropriations for
7 construction of buildings, or repairs of buildings already
8 erected,--power and authority to employ competent person or
9 persons to advise them of the probable cost of the proposed
10 construction or repairs, and making an appropriation for
11 carrying into effect the provisions of this act."

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1907 (P.L.539, No.347),
15 entitled "An act giving the Board of Public Charities,--in the
16 consideration of applications for approval of plans and
17 specifications for the erection of buildings, referred to them
18 by law, and the consideration of applications for
19 recommendations to the Legislature of appropriations for
20 construction of buildings, or repairs of buildings already
21 erected,--power and authority to employ competent person or
22 persons to advise them of the probable cost of the proposed

1 construction or repairs, and making an appropriation for
2 carrying into effect the provisions of this act," is repealed.
3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
