## AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.913, No.367), entitled, as 2 amended, "An act relating to and regulating the practice of 3 the profession of engineering; including civil engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, mining 5 engineering, chemical engineering, surveying and constituent parts and combinations thereof as herein defined; providing for the licensing and registration of persons practicing said 7 8 profession, and the certification of engineers in training, 9 and the suspension and revocation of said licenses, registrations and certifications for violation of this act; 10 prescribing the powers and duties of the State Registration 11 Board for Professional Engineers, the Department of State and 12 13 the courts; prescribing penalties; and repealing existing 14 laws," exempting certain activities from licensure and 15 registration. 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 17 hereby enacts as follows: 18 Section 5, act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.913, No.367), Section 1. 19 known as the "Professional Engineers Registration Law", amended 20 December 13, 1979 (P.L.534, No.120), is amended by adding a 21 subsection to read: 22 Section 5. Exemption from Licensure and Registration. -- \* \* \*
- 23 (i) The writing of deed descriptions as taken from the

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
