1 criminal and/or traffic law enforcement duties, and for the 2 purpose of training only, security officers of first class city 3 housing authority, but shall exclude persons employed to check 4 parking meters and/or to perform only administrative duties, 5 auxiliary and fire police.

7 (6) "Political subdivision" means any county, city, [other
8 than a city of the first class,] borough, incorporated town or

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
