1 2 3 4	Creating a commission to study the feasibility of a transfer of the powers and duties of the Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
б	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Legislative intent.
8	It is the policy of this Commonwealth to help promote an
9	efficient commuter rail system and improve transportation. In
10	the interests of the citizens within this Commonwealth, it is
11	the intent of the General Assembly to promote the health,
12	safety, convenience and welfare through effective and
13	coordinated commuter rail systems.
14	Section 2. Creation of a commission.
15	A legislative commission is hereby created to study and make
16	recommendations pertaining to the feasibility of a transfer of
17	the powers and duties of the Southeastern Pennsylvania
18	Transportation Authority to the Pennsylvania Department of

1 Transportation. The commission shall consist of:

2 (1) One member of the majority party in the House of
3 Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker;

4 (2) one member of the minority party in the House of
5 Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker;

6 (3) one member of the majority party in the Senate to be 7 appointed by the President pro tempore; and

8 (4) one member of the minority party in the Senate to be 9 appointed by the President pro tempore.

10 Section 3. Powers and duties.

11 The commission shall have the power and its duty shall be to 12 perform a study regarding the feasibility of a transfer of the 13 operation, administration, maintenance and funding of the commuter rail division of the Southeastern Pennsylvania 14 15 Transportation Authority to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. The commission shall submit written reports and 16 make recommendations, based upon its findings, within six 17 18 months.

19 Section 4. Review.

The reports and recommendations of the commission shall be submitted to, and reviewed by the transportation committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate.

23 Section 5. Effective date.

24 This act shall take effect immediately.

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
