AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," further providing for the powers and
6 duties of executive directors of intermediate units.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 915-A, act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
10 No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," added May 4,
11 1970 (P.L.311, No.102), is amended to read:

12 Section 915-A. Powers and Duties of Executive Director.--(a)
13 The executive director of an intermediate unit shall have the
14 power and his duty shall be:

15 (1) To administer the intermediate unit program of services.

16 (2) To appoint professional staff subject to the approval of
17 the intermediate unit board of directors.

18 (3) To employ nonprofessional staff in accordance with
19 employment policies of the intermediate unit board of directors.

1 (4) To prepare the budget for adoption by the intermediate
2 unit board of directors.

3 (5) To direct expenditures of funds within the budget or
4 other authorizations of the intermediate unit board of
5 directors.

6 (6) To appoint such advisory groups as will assist the staff
7 in providing programs of services for school districts.

8 (7) To provide the Superintendent of Public Instruction with
9 information, reports and services.

10 (8) To perform such other duties as may be required by the
11 intermediate unit board of directors and the regulations of the
12 State Board of Education.

13 (b) No executive director of an intermediate unit shall be
14 authorized or empowered to reject the appointment or election of
15 a school director from a member school district to the
16 intermediate unit board of directors.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
