In the House of Representatives, September 14, 1982

1 WHEREAS, Equal rights for women should be constitutionally  
2 guaranteed; and

3 WHEREAS, There still exists today discriminatory practices  
4 against women in this society; and

5 WHEREAS, Thirty-five states ratified the original Equal  
6 Rights Amendment; and

7 WHEREAS, Overwhelming majority of Americans continue to  
8 support an Equal Rights Amendment to our Constitution; therefore  
9 be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the  
11 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby urges the Congress of the  
12 United States to act immediately to reintroduce and pass the  
13 Equal Rights Amendment so that the process of state ratification  
14 can begin as quickly as possible; and be it further

15 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be immediately  
16 transmitted to the Speaker of the House, the President pro

1 tempore of the Senate and to each Senator and Congressman from  
2 Pennsylvania.
