8	Section 1. No municipality shall have the power or authority	<

12	number of traffic citations or tickets on any daily, weekly,	
13	monthly, quarterly or yearly basis.	
14	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.	
15	SECTION 1. NO POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR AGENCY OF THE	<
16	COMMONWEALTH SHALL HAVE THE POWER OR AUTHORITY TO ORDER,

- 2 EMPLOYED BY SUCH POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR AGENCY OF THE
- 3 COMMONWEALTH THAT SAID POLICE OFFICER, STATE POLICE OFFICER,
- 4 GAME COMMISSION OFFICER, FISH COMMISSION OFFICER OR ANY OTHER
- 5 OFFICER SHALL ISSUE A CERTAIN NUMBER OF TRAFFIC CITATIONS,
- 6 TICKETS OR ANY OTHER TYPE OF CITATION ON ANY DAILY, WEEKLY,
- 7 MONTHLY, QUARTERLY OR YEARLY BASIS.
- 8 SECTION 2. ANY TICKETS OR CITATIONS ISSUED IN VIOLATION OF
- 9 THIS ACT SHALL BE UNENFORCEABLE, NULL AND VOID.
- 10 SECTION 3. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
