## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for emergency lighting equipment for
- 3 coroners vehicles.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The definition of "emergency vehicle" in section
- 7 102 and subsection (b) of section 4571 of Title 75, act of
- 8 November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania
- 9 Consolidated Statutes, subsection (b) of section 4571 amended
- 10 February 15, 1980 (No.8), are amended to read:
- 11 § 102. Definitions.
- 12 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 13 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific
- 14 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when
- 15 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly
- 16 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:

- 18 "Emergency vehicle." A fire department vehicle, police

- 1 vehicle, ambulance, blood-delivery vehicle, armed forces
- 2 emergency vehicle, one vehicle operated by a coroner or chief
- 3 county medical examiner and one vehicle operated by a chief
- 4 deputy coroner or deputy chief county medical examiner used for
- 5 <u>answering emergency calls</u>, one private vehicle of a fire or
- 6 police chief or assistant chief or ambulance corps commander or
- 7 assistant commander or of a river rescue commander used for
- 8 answering emergency calls or other vehicle designated by the
- 9 State Police under section 6106 (relating to designation of
- 10 emergency vehicles by Pennsylvania State Police).

- 12 § 4571. Visual and audible signals on emergency vehicles.
- 13 \* \* \*
- 14 (b) Police [and], fire and coroner or medical examiner
- 15 vehicles.--
- 16 (1) Police and coroner or medical examiner vehicles may
- in addition to the requirements of subsection (a) be equipped
- 18 with revolving or flashing blue lights. The combination of
- 19 red and blue lights may be used only on police and coroner or
- 20 medical examiner vehicles.
- 21 (2) Unmarked police vehicles, used as emergency vehicles
- and equipped with audible warning systems, may be equipped
- 23 with the lights described in this section.
- 24 (3) Police and fire vehicles may be equipped with a
- 25 mounted rack containing one or more emergency warning lights
- or side mounted floodlights or alley lights or all such
- 27 lights.

- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
