AN ACT

1 Relating to the resignation and reappointment of public
2 officers.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Any public officer within the meaning of such
6 term as used in Article III, section 27, of the Constitution of
7 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania who resigns from office shall
8 be ineligible for reappointment to that office during the
9 remainder of the term for which he was appointed OR FOR A PERIOD <—
10 OF ONE YEAR, WHICHEVER IS LESS, if such reappointment would
11 increase his salary or emoluments. However, nothing contained in
12 this act shall prevent such an officer from being reappointed to
13 the same office from which he resigned if such reappointment
14 does not result in a higher salary obtaining than such person
15 received at the date of his resignation.

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
