8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

12 ~~known as the "General Appropriation Act of 1981," the sum of~~

2 "SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1982."

15 THE PROPER CONDUCT OF THE DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES AND
16 FOR THE PURPOSES HEREINAFTER SET FORTH FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD
17 BEGINNING JULY 1, 1981 AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND
18 REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE
19 30, 1981.

30 SECTION 301. THE FOLLOWING SUMS, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY

1 BE NECESSARY, ARE HEREBY SPECIFICALLY APPROPRIATED FROM THE
 2 GENERAL FUND TO THE SEVERAL HEREINAFTER NAMED AGENCIES OF THE
 3 EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE PAYMENT OF
 4 SALARIES, WAGES OR OTHER COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL EXPENSE OF THE
 5 DULY ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE
 6 COMMONWEALTH, FOR PAYMENT OF FEES OF CONTRACTUAL SERVICES
 7 RENDERED, FOR THE PURCHASE OR RENTAL OF GOODS, SERVICES,
 8 PRINTING, EQUIPMENT, LAND AND BUILDINGS AND FOR PAYMENT OF ANY
 9 OTHER EXPENSES, AS PROVIDED BY LAW OR BY THIS ACT, NECESSARY FOR

9 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

10 SECTION 401. THE FUNDS PROVIDED IN PARTS II AND III ARE IN
11 ADDITION TO ANY FUNDS PROVIDED IN THE ACT OF JUNE 18, 1980
12 (P.L.1391, NO.17A), KNOWN AS THE "GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT OF
13 1980," OR THE ACT OF JULY 1, 1981 (P.L.628, NO.5A), KNOWN AS THE
14 "GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1981."

15 SECTION 402. THE FUNDS PROVIDED IN PART III SHALL BE MADE
16 AVAILABLE FROM FUNDS RESERVED FOR THESE PURPOSES.

17 SECTION 403. AS MUCH OF THE ACT OF JULY 1, 1981 (P.L.628,
18 NO.5A), KNOWN AS THE "GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1981," AS
19 MAKES AN APPROPRIATION TO THE GOVERNOR FOR THE OFFICE OF BUDGET
20 AND ADMINISTRATION, AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
21 COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR GRANTS FOR FLOOD PLAIN MANAGEMENT, AN
22 APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES FOR THE
23 PAYMENT OF TORT CLAIMS AND AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
24 STATE FOR REAPPORTIONMENT EXPENSES, IS REPEALED.

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25 PART V

26 EFFECTIVE DATE

27 SECTION 501. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
