AN ACT

1 Providing for adoption of capital projects to be financed from
2 current revenues of the General Fund and making
3 appropriations.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Itemization and authorization of projects.

7 The 1981-1982 capital budget projects in the categories of
8 public improvement projects and transportation assistance
9 projects, to be financed from current revenues of the General
10 Fund, are hereby itemized together with their respective
11 estimated costs, as follows:

11 Section 2. Appropriations.

12 The following sums of moneys, or as much thereof as may be
13 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated for completion
14 of the above itemized capital improvement projects:

15 (1) The sum of \$50,000 to the Department of
16 Environmental Resources.

17 (2) The sum of \$160,000 to the Department of General
18 Services.

19 (3) The sum of \$60,000 to the Historical and Museum
20 Commission.

21 (4) The sum of \$1,229,000 to the Department of Public
22 Welfare.

23 (5) The sum of \$32,000 to the Department of
24 Transportation.

25 Section 3. Federal and other funds.

26 In addition to those funds appropriated in section 2, all
27 moneys received from the Federal Government or any other source
28 for the capital projects specifically itemized herein are also
29 hereby appropriated for those projects.

30 Section 4. Lapse of funds.

1 Whatsoever of the amounts herein appropriated are unexpended
2 or unencumbered as of June 30, 1983, shall lapse.

3 Section 5. Effective date.

4 This act shall take effect July 1, 1981, or if enacted
5 subsequently, immediately.
