AN ACT

- 1 Requiring a public utility to issue stock for certain price
- 2 increases in their bills; and providing for a Consumers Trust
- Fund for such stock and making the Office of Consumer
- 4 Advocate the trustee and administrator thereof; and creating
- 5 an advisory committee.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Whenever a public utility is authorized by the
- 9 Public Utility Commission to charge its consumers increases in
- 10 their bills because of increases in operating costs due to
- 11 cleaning up after a nuclear accident caused by the utility's
- 12 mismanagement, the public utility shall issue shares of common
- 13 stock equal in value to the total amount of consumer increases
- 14 for such purposes. The stock issued shall be placed in a
- 15 Consumers Trust Fund, the dividends from which shall be paid to
- 16 the public utility to reduce proportionally the amount of all
- 17 its consumers' bills.
- 18 Section 2. The Office of Consumer Advocate shall appoint an

- 1 advisory committee of five members who shall be ordinary
- 2 ratepaying consumers and residential customers of the public
- 3 utility living within its service area who have no other
- 4 financial interest in the utility. The committee shall serve for
- 5 the length of the life of this act. Vacancies shall be filled by
- 6 the Office of Consumer Advocate. The committee shall advise the
- 7 Office of Consumer Advocate on matters relevant to the trust
- 8 fund.
- 9 Section 3. The Office of Consumer Advocate shall be the
- 10 trustee of the Consumer Trust Fund and administer such trust
- 11 fund.
- 12 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
