## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1, 1945 (P.L.1242, No.428), entitled 2 "An act relating to roads, streets, highways and bridges; 3 amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws administered by the Secretary of Highways and by the 5 Department of Highways relating thereto, "further providing 6 for sidewalks along State highways. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 416, act of June 1, 1945 (P.L.1242, 9 10 No.428), known as the "State Highway Law," is amended to read: 11 Section 416. Sidewalks along State Highways. -- [Whenever it 12 shall appear that any part or portion of a State highway in any 13 township is dangerous to the traveling public, and such danger 14 could be materially reduced or lessened by the construction of a 15 sidewalk, the department may aid the local authorities to lay 16 out and construct a sidewalk along such dangerous portion of 17 State highway. Such sidewalks shall be constructed in such manner, and of such materials as deemed advisable by the 18 department, but shall be raised at least five inches above the 19

- 1 surface of the highway. All sidewalks constructed under the
- 2 provisions of this section shall be thereafter considered as a
- 3 part of the State highway system, and shall be reconstructed,
- 4 maintained and repaired, by the department, and the cost or
- 5 proportion thereof agreed to be paid by the department shall be
- 6 paid in the same manner as provided in this act in the case of
- 7 State highways.] The department may construct a sidewalk along
- 8 any highway involved in a project paid in whole or in part with
- 9 Federal funds, if Federal law or regulations require
- 10 construction of a sidewalk. All sidewalks constructed under the
- 11 provisions of this section shall be reconstructed, maintained
- 12 and repaired by the municipality in which the sidewalk is
- 13 <u>located</u>.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
