## AN ACT

14	SECTION 1. SECTION 11 OF THE ACT OF MAY 26, 1982 (P.L.435,	<
15	NO.129), ENTITLED "AN ACT AMENDING TITLE 75 (VEHICLES) OF THE	
16	PENNSYLVANIA CONSOLIDATED STATUTES, FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE	
17	REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION OF VEHICLES AND THE APPOINTMENT AND	
18	CERTIFICATION OF INSPECTION STATIONS AND MECHANICS, " IS AMENDED	
19	BY ADDING A SUBSECTION TO READ:

- 1 (C) INSPECTION MECHANICS CERTIFIED AS TO TRAINING,
- 2 QUALIFICATIONS AND COMPETENCE, PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 1983, SHALL
- 3 <u>BE DEEMED TO HAVE COMPLIED WITH DEPARTMENTAL REGULATIONS AND </u>
- 4 SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTIONS WITHOUT
- 5 REAPPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION.
- 6 SECTION 1. THE DEFINITION OF "RESIDENT" IN SECTION 102 OF

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- 7 TITLE 75 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA CONSOLIDATED STATUTES IS AMENDED TO

- 9 § 102. DEFINITIONS.
- 10 SUBJECT TO ADDITIONAL DEFINITIONS CONTAINED IN SUBSEQUENT
- 11 PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE WHICH ARE APPLICABLE TO SPECIFIC
- 12 PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN
- 13 USED IN THIS TITLE SHALL HAVE, UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY
- 14 INDICATES OTHERWISE, THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION:

- 16 "RESIDENT." A PERSON DWELLING PERMANENTLY OR CONTINUOUSLY
- 17 FOR A PERIOD EXCEEDING [30] 60 CONSECUTIVE DAYS WITHIN THIS
- 18 COMMONWEALTH, EXCEPT THAT A PERSON WHO REGULARLY DWELLS IN TWO
- 19 OR MORE STATES SHALL DECLARE RESIDENCE TO BE IN ANY ONE OF THE
- 20 STATES.

- 22 SECTION 2. SECTIONS 1301 AND 6308(B) OF TITLE 75 ARE AMENDED
- 23 TO READ:
- 24 § 1301. DRIVING UNREGISTERED VEHICLE PROHIBITED.
- 25 (A) GENERAL RULE.--IT IS A SUMMARY OFFENSE FOR ANY PERSON TO
- 26 DRIVE OR FOR AN OWNER KNOWINGLY TO PERMIT TO BE DRIVEN UPON ANY
- 27 HIGHWAY ANY VEHICLE OF A TYPE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER
- 28 THIS CHAPTER WHICH IS NOT REGISTERED OR FOR WHICH THE
- 29 APPROPRIATE FEE HAS NOT BEEN PAID WHEN AND AS REQUIRED IN THIS
- 30 TITLE.

- 1 (B) PROOF OF RESIDENCY.--A PERSON CHARGED UNDER THIS SECTION
- 2 HAS THE BURDEN OF PROVING THAT HE IS A NONRESIDENT WHENEVER HE
- 3 ASSERTS A DEFENSE BASED ON SECTION 1303 (RELATING TO VEHICLES OF
- 4 NONRESIDENTS EXEMPT FROM REGISTRATION). IF HE PRODUCES AT THE
- 5 OFFICE OF THE ISSUING AUTHORITY SATISFACTORY PROOF THAT HE IS A
- NONRESIDENT WITHIN FIVE DAYS AFTER BEING CHARGED WITH A 6
- VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, THE ISSUING AUTHORITY SHALL DISMISS 7
- 8 THE CHARGE.
- 9 (C) PENALTY. -- ANY PERSON VIOLATING THIS SECTION COMMITS A
- 10 SUMMARY OFFENSE AND SHALL, UPON CONVICTION, BE SENTENCED TO PAY
- 11 A FINE OF \$75.
- 12 § 6308. INVESTIGATION BY POLICE OFFICERS.

- 14 (B) AUTHORITY OF POLICE OFFICER.--[ANY] WHENEVER A POLICE
- 15 OFFICER HAS ARTICULABLE AND REASONABLE GROUNDS TO SUSPECT A
- 16 VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE, HE MAY STOP A VEHICLE, UPON REQUEST OR
- 17 SIGNAL, FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSPECTING THE VEHICLE AS TO ITS
- 18 EQUIPMENT AND OPERATION, OR VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OR
- 19 ENGINE NUMBER, OR TO SECURE SUCH OTHER INFORMATION AS THE
- 20 OFFICER MAY REASONABLY BELIEVE TO BE NECESSARY TO ENFORCE THE

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- PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE. 21
