7	Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known

10	Section 442.2. Unemployment Compensation Recipients(a)
11	Notwithstanding any provisions of this act, any person or
12	dependent of that person receiving benefits under the act of
13	December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), known as
14	the "Unemployment Compensation Law," shall be eligible for
15	medical assistance under this act, subject to subsection (b).
16	(b) Medical assistance under subsection (a) shall be limited
17	to outpatient services which shall include, but not be limited
18	to, doctor visits, pharmacy costs, dental expenses, chiropractic

- 1 services, home health services, clinic services and podiatric
- 2 services. Those persons who are covered by a policy of health
- 3 and accident insurance shall be ineligible for medical
- 4 assistance under this section.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
