9	Section 1. The Department of General Services, with the	<
LO	approval of the Governor and the Department of Environmental	
L1	Resources, is hereby authorized to convey to the Piney Run	
L2	Mining Company the following described tract number 1 in	
L3	exchange for tracts numbers 2 and 3 located in Lower Yoder	
L 4	Township, Cambria County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded	
L5	and described as follows:	
L6	SECTION 1. (A) PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION	<
L7	20(B) OF THE ACT OF JUNE 22, 1964 (SP.SESS., P.L.131, NO.8),	
L8	KNOWN AS THE PROJECT 70 LAND ACQUISITION AND BORROWING ACT, THE	
L9	GENERAL ASSEMBLY HEREBY AUTHORIZES THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL	

- 1 SERVICES, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR AND THE DEPARTMENT
- 2 OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES, TO CONVEY TO THE PINEY RUN MINING
- 3 COMPANY THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED TRACT NUMBER 1 IN EXCHANGE FOR
- 4 TRACTS NUMBERS 2 AND 3 LOCATED IN LOWER YODER TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA
- 5 COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.
- 6 (B) SAID LAND CONVEYED TO PINEY RUN MINING COMPANY SHALL BE
- 7 FREE OF RESTRICTIONS ON USE AND ALIENATION PRESCRIBED BY SECTION
- 8 20 OF THE PROJECT 70 LAND ACQUISITION AND BORROWING ACT, UPON
- 9 SUBSTITUTION OF THE PROJECT 70 LAND FOR LAND AT LEAST EQUAL IN
- 10 VALUE, SUBJECT, HOWEVER, TO ALL EXISTING EASEMENTS OF RECORD.
- 11 SECTION 2. THE LAND AUTHORIZED TO BE TRANSFERRED PURSUANT TO
- 12 THIS ACT IS MORE PARTICULARLY BOUNDED AND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
- Tract No. 1
- Beginning at a point at a corner of the Potts and Bheam, Alex
- 15 Stackhouse and Frederick Brehm tract; thence north 56 degrees 27
- 16 minutes west 2007.3 feet to a point on the line of the J. P.
- 17 McConnaughy Estate tract; thence by the line of the J. P.
- 18 McConnaughy Estate tract north 35 degrees 35 minutes east 1400
- 19 feet thence through the Potts and Bheam tract of which this is a
- 20 part, south 56 degrees 27 minutes east 2007.3 feet to a point on
- 21 the line of the Alex Stackhouse tract; thence by the line of the
- 22 Alex Stackhouse tract south 34 degrees 49 minutes west 1400 feet
- 23 to the place of beginning. Containing 65 acres, more or less.
- 24 Title to which became vested in the Commonwealth of
- 25 Pennsylvania by deed of the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy
- 26 recorded in Cambria County Deed Book Volume 866, Page 72, which
- 27 title does not include oil and gas rights, together with the
- 28 associated rights of producing, transporting, introducing,
- 29 storing and withdrawing oil and gas. Excepting and reserving any
- 30 mineral rights the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania may have

- 1 acquired through deed of the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy
- 2 recorded in Cambria County Deed Book Volume 886, Page 72,
- 3 together with all rights necessary or convenient for the removal
- 4 of said minerals.
- 5 Tract No. 2
- 6 Beginning at Stones at the corner of the David Gates tract
- 7 and Frederick Brehm tract and the J. P. McConnaughy Estate
- 8 tract; thence by line of the J. P. McConnaughy Estate tract
- 9 north 34 degrees 43 minutes east 4390 feet to a point and north
- 10 35 degrees 35 minutes east 115.5 feet to a point on the line of
- 11 the Potts and Bheam tract; thence by the Potts and Bheam tract
- 12 south 56 degrees 27 minutes east 750 feet to a point; thence
- 13 through the Frederick Brehm tract of which this formerly was a
- 14 part, south 34 degrees 43 minutes west 4505.5 feet to a point on
- 15 line of the David Gates tract; thence by line of the David Gates
- 16 tract north 56 degrees 27 minutes west 750 feet to Stones and
- 17 place of beginning. Containing 75 acres. Except and reserving
- 18 all the oil and gas underlying said land, together with all
- 19 rights necessary or convenient for the removal of said oil and
- 20 gas.
- 21 Being a part of a larger tract of land conveyed to the Piney
- 22 Run Mining Company by deed of W. David Lloyd, dated September
- 23 13, 1917 and recorded in Cambria County Deed Book Volume 292,
- 24 Page 608.
- 25 Tract No. 3
- 26 Beginning at Stones at the corner of the Edward Lewis tract,
- 27 Alex Stackhouse tract and Potts and Bheam tract thence by the
- 28 Potts and Bheam tract north 33 degrees 50 minutes east 2611.5
- 29 feet to a post on line of the George Bumbernick tract; thence by
- 30 the George Bumbernick tract south 54 degrees 8 minutes east

- 1 377.8 feet to a point; then through the Edward Lewis tract of
- 2 which this was formerly a part south 33 degrees 50 minutes west
- 3 2611.5 feet to a point on the line of the Alex Stackhouse tract;
- 4 thence by the Alex Stackhouse tract north 55 degrees 27 minutes
- 5 west 377.8 feet to stones in the place of beginning. Containing
- 6 22 acres. Except and reserving all oil and gas underlying said
- 7 land, together with all rights necessary or convenient for the
- 8 removal of said oil and gas.
- 9 Being a part of a larger tract of land conveyed to the Piney
- 10 Run Mining Company by deed of W. David Lloyd, dated September
- 11 13, 1917 and recorded in Cambria County Deed Book Volume 292,
- 12 Page 608.
- 13 Section $\frac{2}{3}$. The deed of conveyance shall be approved as
- 14 provided by law and shall be executed by the Secretary of
- 15 General Services in the name of the Commonwealth of
- 16 Pennsylvania.
- 17 Section 3 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
