AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 19, 1982 (No.23A), entitled "An act
2 making an appropriation to the Downingtown Industrial and
3 Agricultural School, Downingtown, Pennsylvania," providing an
4 additional appropriation for certain unpaid bills and debts; <—
5 AND REQUIRING CERTAIN ACTIONS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
6 AND THE OFFICE OF THE AUDITOR GENERAL.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Sections 1 and 2 of the act of June 19, 1982
10 (No.23A), entitled "An act making an appropriation to the
11 Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School, Downingtown,
12 Pennsylvania," are amended to read:

13 Section 1. (a) The sum of \$687,000 is hereby specifically
14 appropriated to the Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural
15 School of Downingtown, Pennsylvania, for the fiscal period July
16 1, 1982 to June 30, 1983, for operation and maintenance of the
17 school.

18 (b) The sum of \$489,000 is hereby specifically appropriated
19 to the Downingtown Industrial and Agricultural School of

1 Downingtown, Pennsylvania, for the fiscal period July 1, 1982 to
2 June 30, 1983 for the payment of bills and debts due, but unpaid
3 as of June 30, 1982.

4 Section 2. (A) Payments to the Downingtown Industrial and <—
5 Agricultural School on account of the appropriation provided in
6 subsection (a) of section 1 shall be made by the Secretary of
7 Education in equal quarterly payments.

8 (B) THE OFFICE OF THE AUDITOR GENERAL SHALL CONDUCT AN AUDIT <—
9 OF THE DOWNINGTOWN INDUSTRIAL AND AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL.

10 (C) THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL EVALUATE THE ACADEMIC
11 PROGRAMS AT THE DOWNINGTOWN INDUSTRIAL AND AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL
12 SIMILAR TO THE EVALUATIONS CONDUCTED AT PRIVATE ACADEMIC
13 SCHOOLS. SUBSEQUENT TO THIS EVALUATION, THE ADMINISTRATION AT
14 THE SCHOOL, WITH THE AID OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, WILL
15 DEVELOP ACADEMIC GOALS SUPPORTED BY SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES TO BE
16 ACHIEVED BY THE STUDENTS AT THE SCHOOL. THIS INFORMATION, ALONG
17 WITH A LIST OF THE COURSES REQUIRED TO ACHIEVE THESE GOALS AND
18 OBJECTIVES, WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE HOUSE AND
19 SENATE MAJORITY AND MINORITY APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEES WITHIN
20 SIX MONTHS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT.

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
