AN ACT

Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled 2 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration 3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes from State and local taxation and making an appropriation," 7 providing a trust fund for distribution of excess lottery 8 proceeds. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Section 12 of the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State Lottery Law, is amended by 12 13 adding a subsection to read: 14 Section 12. Disposition of Funds from Sale of Tickets or Shares.--* * * 15 (c) All excess funds not distributed pursuant to subsection 16 17 (b) shall be deposited in a restricted receipts fund 18 administered by a board consisting of eleven persons, five of whom shall be appointed by the Governor of whom two shall be 19

senior citizens, two by the President pro tempore of the Senate,

- two by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the State 1
- 2 Treasurer and the Chairman of the State Lottery Commission. The
- 3 board shall determine how excess funds shall be distributed,
- 4 with the advice of the Secretary of Aging. All excess
- 5 distribution shall be restricted to use for the benefit of
- 6 senior citizens, widows, widowers and the permanently disabled.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
