AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of April 5, 1849 (P.L.397, No.296), entitled 2 "An act to prevent the opening of streets or public roads
- through burial grounds, and for the protection of cemeteries
- 4 and grave yards, prohibiting the opening of highways through
- 5 cemeteries in Philadelphia.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of April 5, 1849 (P.L.397,
- 9 No.296), entitled "An act to prevent the opening of streets or
- 10 public roads through burial grounds, and for the protection of
- 11 cemeteries and grave yards, " is amended to read:
- 12 Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of
- 13 Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General
- 14 Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the
- 15 same. That hereafter it shall not be lawful to open any street,
- 16 lane, alley or public road through any burial ground or cemetery
- 17 within this Commonwealth, any laws heretofore passed to the
- 18 contrary notwithstanding[: Provided, That this section shall not
- 19 extend to the City and County of Philadelphia].

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
