AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 18 19 20 commissions shall be determined, " requiring the purchase of 21 products and services from sources within the Commonwealth. 22 PREPARATION OF AN IMPACT REPORT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL 23 SERVICES.

- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 25 hereby enacts as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 2 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a
- 3 section to read:
- 4 <u>Section 529. Purchase of Products and Services within the</u> <-
- 5 Commonwealth. (a) All products purchased by any administrative
- 6 department, board or commission, or any independent board or
- 7 commission, shall be manufactured in Pennsylvania. All services
- 8 purchased by any administrative department, board or commission,
- 9 <u>or any independent board or commission shall be purchased from</u>
- 10 persons who are residents of the Commonwealth.
- 11 (b) The limitation on the purchasing of products or services
- 12 in subsection (a) shall not apply if the Department of General
- 13 <u>Services certifies that the product or service is not made or</u>
- 14 otherwise available by a Pennsylvania manufacturer or resident
- 15 <u>or if the purchase is economically prohibitive.</u>
- 16 Section 2. This act shall apply to contracts for products
- 17 and services executed or renewed on or after the effective date
- 18 of this act.
- 19 Section 3. This act shall take effect in six months.
- 20 <u>SECTION 2418. IMPACT REPORT.--THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL</u>
- 21 SERVICES SHALL, BY DECEMBER 31, 1984, PREPARE AND TRANSMIT A
- 22 REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE IMPACT OF THE PURCHASES BY
- 23 THE COMMONWEALTH OF SUPPLIES, MATERIALS, FURNISHINGS, PRINTING
- 24 EQUIPMENT, AUTOMOBILES AND OTHER PRODUCTS OR SERVICES ON
- 25 EMPLOYMENT OF PENNSYLVANIA RESIDENTS AND DEVELOP A PLAN BY WHICH
- 26 SUCH PURCHASES COULD INCREASE THE EMPLOYMENT OF PENNSYLVANIA
- 27 RESIDENTS.
- 28 SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
