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## AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An  
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain  
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial  
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the  
5 laws relating thereto," requiring legislative approval for  
6 certain curriculum regulations.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known  
10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a  
11 section to read:

12 Section 1521. Legislative Approval of Curriculum

13 Regulations.--The State Board of Education, when submitting for <—  
14 publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin any proposed regulation

1 ~~relating to 22 Pa. Code Ch. 5 (relating to general curriculum~~  
2 ~~requirements), shall present the proposed regulation to the~~  
3 ~~Senate Education Committee and the House Education Committee for~~  
4 ~~approval. The State Board of Education shall not finally adopt~~  
5 ~~any such proposed regulation until such proposed regulation has~~  
6 ~~been approved by a majority of members of both the Senate~~  
7 ~~Education Committee and the House Education Committee. ANY~~ <—  
8 REVISION TO 22 PA. CODE CH. 5 (RELATING TO GENERAL CURRICULUM  
9 REQUIREMENTS) PUBLISHED IN THE PENNSYLVANIA BULLETIN ON OR  
10 SUBSEQUENT TO JANUARY 22, 1983 SHALL FALL UNDER THE PROVISIONS  
11 OF THE ACT OF JUNE 25, 1982 (P.L.633, NO.181), KNOWN AS THE  
12 REGULATORY REVIEW ACT. CONSIDERATION OF ANY PROPOSED REVISION TO  
13 CHAPTER 5 SHALL PROVIDE FOR GENERAL ASSEMBLY REVIEW PURSUANT TO  
14 THE REGULATORY REVIEW ACT. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE REGULATORY  
15 REVIEW PROCEDURES REQUIRED BY ALL SECTIONS OF THE REGULATORY  
16 REVIEW ACT SHALL VOID ALL PROPOSED CHANGES TO CHAPTER 5.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
