AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An
2 act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and
3 brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and
4 changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and
5 restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession,
6 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding
7 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic
8 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the
9 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and
10 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing
11 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores,
12 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective
13 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain
14 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure
15 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures;
16 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws,"
17 providing for permits for certain organizations to operate
18 small games of chance for fundraising purposes; and making a
19 general repeal.

20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
21 hereby enacts as follows:

22 Section 1. The act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known
23 as the Liquor Code, is amended by adding a section to read:

24 Section 476. Small Games of Chance Permits.--(a) Any
25 hospital, church, synagogue, volunteer fire company, bona fide

1 sportsmen's club in existence for at least ten years or more
2 shall upon submission of an application satisfactory to the
3 board, be granted a three-day permit to operate small games of
4 chance for fundraising purposes.

5 (b) The fee for this permit shall be twenty-five dollars
6 (\$25).

7 (c) Small games of chance shall include, but not be limited
8 to, those games known as:

9 (1) Bingo Strips.

10 (2) Fish Bowl.

11 (3) Big-6.

12 (4) Wheel.

13 (5) Instant Bingo.

14 Section 2. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar
15 as they are inconsistent with this act.

16 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
