AN ACT

- 1 Making an emergency appropriation to the Philadelphia School
- 2 District, to be used for repair and replacement costs
- incurred as a result of problems caused by asbestos.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The sum of \$17,700,000, or as much thereof as may
- 7 be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Philadelphia School
- 8 District to be used for repair and replacement costs incurred as
- 9 a result of problems caused by asbestos. The moneys shall be
- 10 allocated as follows:

- 6 Class C schools includes all schools with problems relating

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
