AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for rear bumpers.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 4536 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 4536. Bumpers.
- 8 No person shall operate any vehicle upon a highway without
- 9 bumpers of a type specified by regulations of the department in
- 10 both the front and rear unless the vehicle was originally
- 11 designed and manufactured to be used without bumpers. This
- 12 section shall not apply to any special mobile equipment or
- 13 implement of husbandry that is not so equipped by the original
- 14 manufacturer. The regulations shall require downward extensions
- 15 on rear bumpers of vehicles and trailers that are elevated to
- 16 such a height that small passenger cars could possibly pass
- 17 partially under the vehicle.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
