A SUPPLEMENT

- 1 To the act of (P.L. , No.), entitled "An act providing for
- the capital budget for the fiscal year 1983-1984," providing
- for an additional project; and making an appropriation.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Total authorization.
- 7 The total authorization for the additional capital project in
- 8 the category of public improvement project itemized in section 2
- 9 and to be acquired or constructed by the Department of General
- 10 Services, its successors or assigns, and to be financed by the
- 11 incurring of debt, shall be \$3,319,000.
- 12 Section 2. Itemization of public improvement project.
- 13 An additional capital project in the category of public
- 14 improvement project to be constructed or acquired by the
- 15 Department of General Services, its successors or assigns, and
- 16 to be financed by the incurring of debt, is hereby itemized,
- 17 together with its respective estimated financial costs as
- 18 follows:

14	Section 3. Debt authorization.			
15	The Governor, Auditor General and State Treasurer are hereby			
16	authorized and directed to borrow, from time to time, in			
17	addition to any authorization heretofore or hereafter enacted,			
18	on the credit of the Commonwealth, subject to the limitations			
19	provided in the current capital budget, money not exceeding in			
20	the aggregate the sum of \$3,319,000 as may be found necessary to			
21	carry out the acquisition and construction of the public			
22	improvement project specifically itemized in a capital budget.			
23	Section 4. Issue of bonds.			
24	The indebtedness herein authorized shall be incurred from			
25	time to time and shall be evidenced by one or more series of			
26	general obligation bonds of the Commonwealth in such aggregate			
27	principal amount for each series as the Governor, Auditor			
28	General and State Treasurer shall determine, but the latest			
29	stated maturity date shall not exceed the estimated useful life			
30	of the project being financed as stated in section 5.			

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- 1 Section 5. Estimated useful life of project.
- 2 The General Assembly states that the estimated useful life of
- 3 the public improvement project heretofore itemized is 30 years.
- 4 The maximum term of the debt authorized to be incurred hereunder
- 5 is 30 years.
- 6 Section 6. Appropriation.
- 7 The net proceeds of the sale of the obligations herein
- 8 authorized are hereby appropriated from the Capital Facilities
- 9 Fund to the Department of General Services in the maximum amount
- 10 of \$3,319,000 to be used by it exclusively to defray the
- 11 financial cost of the public improvement project specifically
- 12 itemized in a capital budget. After reserving or paying the
- 13 expenses of the sale of the obligation, the State Treasurer
- 14 shall pay to the Department of General Services the moneys as
- 15 required and certified by it to be legally due and payable.
- 16 Section 7. Federal funds.
- 17 In addition to those funds appropriated in section 6, all
- 18 moneys received from the Federal Government for the project
- 19 specifically itemized herein are also hereby appropriated for
- 20 this project.
- 21 Section 8. Repeals.
- 22 Subclause (8) of Clause VIII of section 2 of the act of
- 23 August 14, 1963 (P.L.1032, No.451), entitled "An act amending
- 24 the act of March 31, 1949 (P.L.372, No.34), entitled 'An act to
- 25 promote the welfare of the people of the Commonwealth; creating
- 26 The General State Authority as a body corporate and politic with
- 27 power to construct, improve, equip, furnish, and operate
- 28 projects, and to lease the same, and to fix fees, rentals, and
- 29 charges for the use thereof; authorizing and regulating the
- 30 issuance of bonds for said Authority, and providing for the

- 1 payment of such bonds, and the rights of the holders thereof;
- 2 and to enter into agreements with the Government of the United
- 3 States or any Federal agency; and authorizing the Department of
- 4 Property and Supplies to grant, assign, convey, or lease to the
- 5 Authority lands of the Commonwealth and interests therein and to
- 6 acquire lands therefor; granting the right of eminent domain;
- 7 empowering The General State Authority to sell and convey
- 8 projects and property to the Commonwealth; and providing that no
- 9 debt of the Commonwealth shall be incurred in the exercise of
- 10 any of the powers granted by this act, 'increasing the powers
- 11 and the borrowing capacity of the Authority, allocating the
- 12 proceeds of such borrowing capacity, and regulating the leasing
- 13 of projects constructed for State aided institutions," is hereby
- 14 repealed. Any funds expended or encumbered under the
- 15 authorization contained in the act of August 14, 1963, shall be
- 16 transferred to the authorization in section 2(6)(B).
- 17 Section 9. Effective date.
- 18 This act shall take effect immediately.
