AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting the transfer of certain human organs for valuable
 2 consideration.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Prohibition of organ purchases.
- 6 (a) General rule. -- It is unlawful for any person to
- 7 knowingly acquire, receive or otherwise transfer any human organ
- 8 for valuable consideration.
- 9 (b) Penalty. -- Any person who violates subsection (a) commits
- 10 a misdemeanor of the first degree and, upon conviction, shall be
- 11 fined not more than \$50,000 or imprisoned not more than five
- 12 years, or both.
- 13 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section the following
- 14 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 15 subsection:
- 16 "Human organ." The human kidney, liver, heart, lung,

- 1 pancreas and any other human organ or tissue including corneas,
- 2 bone and skin.
- "Valuable consideration." Does not include the reasonable 3
- 4 costs associated with the removal, storage and transportation of
- 5 a human organ, but includes any other consideration.
- 6 Section 2. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect immediately.
