Amending the act of October 28, 1966 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.55, 2 No.7), entitled "An act defining, regulating and relating to 3 retail installment contracts for all goods and services except certain motor vehicles and home improvements; 5 prescribing the requirements of such contracts and limitations on the enforcement thereof; and providing remedies and penalties, "further providing for the minimum 8 service charge. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Sections 501(c) and 904(b) of the act of October 12 28, 1966 (1st Sp.
