## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581),
- 2 entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending
- and consolidating the law relating to boroughs, " authorizing
- 4 appropriations for neighborhood crime watch programs.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 1202 of the act of February 1, 1966 (1965
- 8 P.L.1656, No.581), known as The Borough Code, is amended by
- 9 adding a clause to read:
- 10 Section 1202. Specific Powers.--The powers of the borough
- 11 shall be vested in the corporate authorities. Among the specific
- 12 powers of the borough shall be the following, and in the
- 13 exercise of any of such powers involving the enactment of any
- 14 ordinance or the making of any regulation, restriction or
- 15 prohibition, the borough may provide for the enforcement thereof
- 16 and may prescribe penalties for the violation thereof or for the
- 17 failure to conform thereto:
- 18 \* \* \*

- 1 (79) Appropriations for Neighborhood Crime Watch Programs.
- 2 To appropriate annually an amount toward a neighborhood crime
- 3 watch program. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no
- 4 borough or official thereof shall become subject to contractual,
- 5 tort or other liability as a result of having made an
- 6 appropriation pursuant to this clause.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
