AN ACT

1 Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581),
2 entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending
3 and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," authorizing
4 appropriations for neighborhood crime watch programs.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1202 of the act of February 1, 1966 (1965
8 P.L.1656, No.581), known as The Borough Code, is amended by
9 adding a clause to read:

10 Section 1202. Specific Powers.--The powers of the borough
11 shall be vested in the corporate authorities. Among the specific
12 powers of the borough shall be the following, and in the
13 exercise of any of such powers involving the enactment of any
14 ordinance or the making of any regulation, restriction or
15 prohibition, the borough may provide for the enforcement thereof
16 and may prescribe penalties for the violation thereof or for the
17 failure to conform thereto:

18 * * *

1 (79) Appropriations for Neighborhood Crime Watch Programs.
2 To appropriate annually an amount toward a neighborhood crime
3 watch program. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no
4 borough or official thereof shall become subject to contractual,
5 tort or other liability as a result of having made an
6 appropriation pursuant to this clause.
7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
